GRADES

ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE GRADED USING THE AP RUBRIC. STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP CRITIQUES, DISCUSSING THEIR OWN WORK AND THE WORK OF THEIR PEERS.

COURSE DESKIPTION

THIS COURSE IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH AN IN-DEPTH INVESTIGATION OF ALL THREE ASPECTS OF THE AP STUDIO ART PORTFOLIO WHICH INCLUDE QUALITY, CONCENTRATION AND BREADTH. STUDENTS WILL BEGIN THE SEMESTER WORKING ON THEIR BREADTH SECTION TO ALLOW THEM TO EXPERIMENT WITH MATERIALS AND SUBJECTS, AND MASTER THEIR STUDIO SKILLS AND CONCEPTS. STUDENTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO MASTER LAB/TECNHICAL SKILLS, COMPOSITIONAL TECHNIQUES, AND THE INVESITGATION AND EXECUTION OF IDEAS. STUDENTS WILL BE SHOWN PAST AP PORTFOLIOS FOR BENCHMARKS AND INSPIRATION. SPECIAL EMPHASIS WILL BE PLACED ON COMMUNICATION THROUGH COMPOSITION AND DESIGN.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 2. GAIN KNOWLEDGE OF HISTORICALLY SIGNIFICANT ARTISTS, BOTH PAST AND PRESENT, AND UTILIZE
- THEM AS INFLUENCES ON INDIVIDUAL CONCEPTS AND CREATIVE EXPRESSION. 3. LEARN TO CONCEPTUALIZE AND EXERCISE CRITICAL JUDGEMENT BASED ON FORMAL CONCEPTS.
- 4. PARTICIPATE IN CRITIQES AND DISCUSS THEIR OWN WORK AS WELL AS THE WORK OF PEERS. 5. EXPLORE CONCENTRATION TOPICS IN DEPTH; STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO DEVELOP A BODY OF WORK
- THAT IS AN INVESTIGATION OF A THEME OR AN IDEA. 6. MAKE PURPOSEFUL DECISIONS ABOUT HOW TO USE THE ELEMENTS AND PRINCIPLES OF DESIGN IN AN
- 7. DEVELOP OWN IDEAS VERBALLY AND IN WRITING REGARDING OWN WORK. STUDENTS WILL USE THE AP RUBRIC TO EVALUATE THEIR WORK AND EXAMINE HOW TO MOVE THE WORK FORWARD FROM MID-RANGE
- 8. COMPILE AND COMPLETE THE AP STUDIO ART 2D PORTFOLIO IN THE THREE GIVEN AREAS: QUALITY, WORK TO HIGHER LEVEL ACHIEVEMENT.
- READTH AND CONCENTRATION.

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ALL WORK MUST BE ORIGINAL. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO DEVELOP THEIR OWN PERSONAL IMAGERY. WHEN PUBLISHED PHOTOGRAPHS OR THE WORKS OF OTHER ARTISTS ARE USED THEY SHOULD BE IN THE SERVICE OF A PERSONAL VISION. ANY PUBLISHED IMAGES SHOULD BE ALTERED IN SUCH A SUBSTANTIAL WAY THAT IT MOVES BEYOND JUST DUPLICATION . THIS IS A MATTER OF ARTISTIC INTEGRITY.

RECOVERY POLICY

HIGH SCHOOL VERSION QUOTED DIRECTLY FROM THE POLICY: PROVISION FOR IMPROVING GRADES
