LETTERS OF THE WILD

PROJECT

Letters can be discovered in natural and man-made forms, found in shadows, or made by cropping with the frame of the camera. It is important to understand that typography is not just text, but an artform.

You must locate objects, lines and forms which most resemble each letter of the alphabet. Be creative! Fill your frame with the "letter" to be sure it is obvious which letter the viewer should be looking for.

Your letters *MUST* be natural ... you cannot "create" them.

You must have a photograph for each letter. However, feel free to take more than one photograph for a letter!

You can use your own camera (digital, point-n-shoot, Polaroid, etc) for this assignment. You can use one of my digital cameras. These photos can be taken in class or at home.
