What to shoot?

Individually, you need to shoot 25 to 30 images ... walk down your street or a street nearby, and photograph what you see. Begin to think about composition ... what's your subject? Where is it within your frame? What else is going?

As you are composing your photographs, pay attention to the background. Keep your backgrounds simple ... uncluttered. This will allow the viewer's attention to be focused on the subject.

The camera should be set on manual settings:

manual mode

you will decide on the shutter speed, aperture and ISO that best suits your available lighting

*You will need to shoot all of these photographs outside with this setting.
